Our Basic Understanding As an intercultural community, we all do our best for successful learning and respectful interaction with one another.

1. School Start & Attendance

- We begin lessons together at 7:45 AM -- please be punctual.
- During your school day, please remain on school grounds continuously. Students in grades 11 and 12 may leave the school grounds during lunch break or free periods with written parental permission. (Further details are regulated by the upper school coordination.)

2. Learning Atmosphere & Behavior in the Building

- During lessons, we maintain quiet in the building. This helps everyone with concentrated work.
- For playing and running, please use exclusively the schoolyard.
- Please only enter subject-specific rooms when accompanied by your teacher.

3. Breaks & Safety

- During poor air quality (red light in the foyer), the playground is unfortunately closed. You can then stay in the classrooms or use the cafeteria and large gymnasium.
- From May to October, grades 5-9 are also welcome to spend their breaks in the classrooms.
- Please leave glass bottles at home.
- For football, please use foam balls; basketballs are available from the break supervisors. Our climbing equipment is used exclusively by elementary school students only, without exception, according to the agreed rules.

4. Respect & Community

- Look out for each other and please resolve problems respectfully without physical or emotional harm. If you need help, please contact: supervisory staff, our school social work, your class and trusted teachers, or our peer mediators.
- Everyone please help with order and cleanliness and dispose of waste in the appropriate containers.
- Please treat private and school property with care. If damage occurs nonetheless, the responsible parties and their parents please take independent responsibility for replacement or repair.
- Dear parents, you are always warmly welcome in the foyer. If you have any concerns, we kindly ask that you arrange an appointment in advance with our staff or school administration – please be sure to follow GISAD's established conversation guidelines.

5. Additional Important Rules

- Please use electronic devices only within the permitted framework and use online access exclusively for school purposes. The youth protection settings help us all.
- Please leave chewing gum at home. It can cause mess in the school building. Thank you for your understanding!
- Students from grade 8 and all adults please ensure that on school grounds their torso, shoulders, knees, and tattoos are appropriately covered.
- Please pay attention to healthy food and drinks.
- Our rules regarding dangerous or harmful objects are very important to us. Please follow the corresponding rules and keep in mind that replicas of weapons, lighters, cigarettes, e-cigarettes/vapes, or other unwanted items should also reliably stay at home.
- Since no delivery service is certified by ADEK, orders will be confiscated and handed over to parents or donated to our housekeeping.
